

Upcoming Storm Water Quality Control Inspections

Don't be surprised if you see members of the City Engineer's office out and about in our neighborhood. They will soon begin annually inspecting all of the storm sewer inlets and outfalls serving the City. The purpose of the inspections is to identify and remediate any suspicious or illicit discharges in accordance with federal and state environmental regulations, as well as City Ordinance 2009-09.

The City's storm water map has been divided into seven inspection zones. Each zone will be inspected at least once per year according to the following schedule:

Zone 1 – January and/or July;

Zone 2 – February and/or August;

Zones 3 & 4 – March and/or September;

Zone 5 – April and/or October;

Zone 6 – May and/or November;

Zone 7 – June and/or December.

If you would like to know which inspection zone your property is located within, please review the Olmos Park storm water map, which is available on the City's website. Also, citizens are encouraged to contact the City offices if they observe a suspicious discharge that could affect water quality. –David Johnson, Givler Engineering, Inc.
